Severe anemia cases: Extensively reviewed by the chairperson. Maternal and infant death data owing to severe anemia must be separately shown. The Chairperson instructed all CDC's to look after teen age pregnancy. A segregated and break up of such data to be mandatorily maintained. IoS to coordinate. He asked EE concerned to look into the matter and seek help from other concerned departments if required. Further asked FY 2023-24 works to be completed as soon as possible. The Chairperson discussed with EE, PWD(R) (Jorhat-Titabar) the construction issue relating to the road linking Northern Gate of AF station, Jorhat to JMCH. EE explained the entire matter. The Chairperson instructed EE to pay one more visit and prepare a comprehensive report along with an appropriate estimate proposal and subsequently send it 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> EE. The chairperson strictly instructed that all works for FY 2022-23 and 2023-24 should not be dragged any further and completed as soon as possible. MM Unnata Pakipath (FY 2023-24) works including Malow Ali 1 km stretch observed to be very slow. The chairperson instructed to speed it up. The Chairperson instructed that road markings should not be missed on completed roads. Chairperson instructed that continuously slow performing contractors like Yerool Hussain, should be written against. If they fail to show satisfactory progress by next DDC meeting. RIDF 2023-24 works instructed to be completed by June' 2026. SOPD-ODF: for FY 2023-24 under Teok, 01 nos. of road. The chairperson instructed EE to ask contractor to report to CDC Teok. Subsequently CDC Teok & EE PWD (R) Teok & Mariani will brief on the 1.5 km road status and on how to complete it, back to the chairperson. EE informed the committee that an alternative road has been sanctioned by govt. as proposed by PWD(R) Teok-Mariani pertaining to the village near army campus at Rowriah. Continue works both on the clear stretch and the stretch with LA issues, wherever work is possible. The clearing of LA issue is a temporal matter, entire stretch may not be clear all at once, works on cleared zones should not stop. ii. EE, PWD(R) Nazira must cooperate at all cost, confirm any obstruction related matter, and sort it out with the help of District Administration, Jorhat.
