PROHIBITORY ORDER U/S 144 Cr.P.C.

Whereas, it appears to the undersigned that due to the prevailing law & order situation in the Jorhat district and for apprehension of breach of public peace and tranquillity owing to various reasons, necessary steps are needed to be taken urgently to prevent any untoward incident, breach of public peace and tranquillity, activities endangering public life and property etc in the District.

Therefore, I Sri Ashok Kumar Barman, IAS District Magistrate, Jorhat, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 Cr.P.C., do hereby promulgate the prohibitory order on the following activities throughout Jorhat district with immediate effect;

- I. Assembly of five or more persons in any public places without permission.
- II. Carrying of lethal weapons and arms in public places including lathis, daggers, sticks, spears, swords etc.
- III. Public rally, procession without permission and demonstrations, strikes including hunger strike, dharnas, shouting slogans etc in public places, causing obstruction to public roads, highways, footpath and normal movement of traffic etc.
- IV. Carrying of any kind of inflammable objects including fire mashal, candle, effigy, tyre etc. to be burnt by any individual or group of persons at any public place, road, in front of Government Offices, residence of any Public Servant, Renowned person and Public Representatives of Jorhat District, raising Shahid bedies in Govt./Semi-Govt. land.
- V. Training in public places, by way of drill etc with weapons lathis etc.
- VI. Forcible collection of fund or subscription from public/lotteries/gambling at public places including roads, highways, Govt. offices.
- VII. Bursting or throwing of crackers etc. inflammable materials on the street or on public/ pedestrians/ moving or stationery vehicles.
- VIII. Throwing of colours and / or any objectionable materials in public places, on members of the general public, particularly women and children. (Gathering or grouping /loitering, assembling at street corners, road junctions, footpaths, and eve-teasing etc.)
- IX. Using of Loud Speaker in high volumes near hospitals/Courts in Session, educational institutions etc.
- X. Inflammatory speeches communal or anti-state/anti national speeches/ slogans/banners/pestering/ wall writing etc.
- XI. Use of tinted or opaque glasses (Dark Glasses)/vacuums horns. Coloured/ blinding lights and driving with high beam lights in all vehicles particularly within town limits.
- XII. Wearing of olive green uniform (Army Uniforms/ Combat dresses/Fatigues).


Owing to the necessity of the situation, this order is passed ex-parte under section 144(2) Cr. P.C. However, anyone aggrieved by the order may approach the competent authority for modification/waiver of the order.

This order come into force with immediate effect and will remain in force until further order.

Any violation of this order is punishable U/S 188 IPC.

ORDER

WHEREAS, reliable information is being received time to time from the Intelligence branch and district police that some extremist organizations are trying to sneak into the state from the Nagaland Border to create trouble in the Jorhat District;

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to me that movement of public in Assam - Nagaland border areas particularly between dusk to dawn is likely to hamper public peace and tranquillity and subsequently there is apprehension of Law & order problem in the District;

WHEREAS, the imposition of prohibition order under section 144 Cr.P.C along with night curfew in the Assam Nagaland bordering area has been a long standing practice which had played an important role in prevention of interstate crimes and anti-national activities. It has also served as effective deterrent against extremist activity. Criminals who are sneaking into and moving out of Jorhat district to the adjoining districts have been using the Assam Nagaland border as a transit route. They are always attempting disruptive and criminal activities in Jorhat as well as other districts of Assam via this route.

WHEREAS, according to source report it is learnt that some report ULFA(I) recently enrolled new volunteers in their group and they may used the Assam Nagaland border areas of transporting new volunteers and other purposes.


Therefore, I Sri Ashok Kumar Barman, IAS, District Magistrate, Jorhat in exercise of powers conferred upon me under 144 Cr.P.C. and having been convinced, do hereby prohibit movement of all kinds of vehicles/ persons etc. within 5KM belt on the Assam side of Assam Nagaland border from 8.00 pm to 5.00 am and thereby impose NIGHT CURFEW from DUSK TO DAWN in the aforesaid area;

This order will however not be applicable to ARMY/SECURITY PERSONNEL/POLICE ON DUTY/MAGISTRATES ON DUTY/FOREST OFFICIAL ON DUTY and other law enforcing agencies. Owing to necessity of the situation this order is being passed ex-parte U/S 144(2) Cr.P.C.

This order comes into force with immediate effect and will remain in-force until further orders. Any person aggrieved by the order can approach the undersigned with specific ground for modification/to rescind or alter/exempt this order.

Any violation of this order is punishable U/S 188, I.P.C.
