MINUTES OF DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING OF JORHAT DISTRICT FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY '2022 HELD ON 11/01/2022, IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, JORHAT

The members present are at Annexure I.

The meeting was presided over by Sri Ashok Kr. Barman, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat. The Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat welcomed all the members present and initiated the discussion.

At the outset, the Chairperson appealed all the members of Dist Development Committee to attend the monthly DDC meeting regularly without fail for fruitful discussion of departmental matter as well as interdepartmental issues and next onwards absent without prior information action will be initiated against such absentees.

The progress of works of various development departments were elaborately discussed in the meeting and decision arrived as follows:

The Chairperson appealed all HoDs to keep their office premises clean and maintain a plastic free zone to the best possible extent. In this connection, the Chairperson also appealed for 15 days office Cleaning Abhiyan and He said that the best Office will be awarded in the ensuing Republic Day celebration.

1. Handloom & Textile

On a query from Chair, the Asstt. Dir., H&T, Jrt, informed that out of the total target of 200 under Mudra Loan, office has forwarded 109 applications so far, but only 2 (two) cases sanctioned and issued loan till date. The Chairperson proposed for a special review meeting on Mudra Loan with Bank authority (LDM) to be held for detail discussion on such issues where Sericulure/Vety/Fishery/Industries Departments should also be present. The Chairperson requested the Asstt. Director, H&T, to take target for creation of 1000 skill weavers in Jorhat district apart from their normal schemes.

2. IRRIGTION

The Chairperson has focused on tie up of Agriculture and Irrigation department for execution PMKSY. He also highlighted on development of year round cropping system. The Chairperson requested the EE, Irrigation, Jorhat/Dergaon/ Teok Divn, to take up farming activities in collaboration with NABARD for year round cropping involving new crops like Maize etc. The Chairperson also appealed the EE, Irrigation to motivate the farmers of Elengmora/Jhanj area for multiple cropping and to avail Govt, provided irrigation facility.

3. SOIL CONSERVATION

The DO, Soil Conservation, Jorhat was requested to prepare the DPR for the New Generation Watershed Development Project and submit the same by Feb.15th /2022 after consultation and in coordination with Agriculture, Fishery, Irrigation and any other related departments.

4. LABOUR

The Asstt. Commissioner, Labour, Jorhat informed that under "e-SHRAM", out of the target of 3 lakhs, 1.50 lakhs registration has been done so far. He also requested for set up of Sram Sewa Kendra at each Office as per convenience for registration of unorganized labour under their control. For the registration process, 4 (four) basic conditions were laid out, which are as 1. Age group from 16-59 yrs. 2. Should not fall any Income Tax slab 3. Should not avail any benefits under ESI/PF scheme. 4. Should be a casual worker.

5. PWD

Regarding allotment of Land for Women University, Assam the Chairperson instructed the EE PWD (B), Jorhat to communicate with ADC (Rev.), Jorhat immediately and submit letter to Govt. and regarding outstanding payment of Treasury Building, EE was also directed to write a letter to the Director, Accounts & Treasuries, Assam with an intimation to the District Administration.

- A discussion was also held regarding construction of Freedom Park. Jorhat and its funding.
- 7. The Chairman instructed the PWD (Roads) department to start the remaining works of construction of link road from Rajabari to Chinamora Maszid and remove all encroachment leading to entrance of DTO, Office, The EE PWD (R) was also instructed to make a joint inspection with Circle Officer concerned immediately and submit report.
- The Chairperson asked the DGM, APDCL, Jorhat to place a joint sitting with NHIDCL to resolve all pending issues related to Highway Authority in DC's presence.
- The Chairperson discussed issues relating to pending works of Multistoried Car Parking.
 The Chairperson also instructed the Dy. Dir, T&CP to convene a meeting to sort out the existing problems and Hon'ble MLA. Jorhat also to be invited in the meeting.

The Chairperson instructed the Dy. Dir., T&CP, to write a letter to the Department of Elementary Education, Assam, through DEEO, Jorhat for requisition of Land approximately 4 Kathas from Normal School for setting up of Multistoried Office Building.

- 10. The Chairperson instructed the DFDO, Jorhat for identification, preparation and conservation of Wet Land in the District. He was also instructed for creation of Water Bodies and there by storage of water keeping in view of the rapid rate of depletion of ground water level. He was also instructed to develop hatchery plant and take up other related entrepreneurial activities.
- 11. The Chairperson pointed out the idea of setting up of a Standard Canteen for Officers and Staff of various Govt. Department under registration of Coop Societies and instructed the ARCS. Jorhat to take necessary steps in this regards and intimate.

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- 13. The Chairperson appreciated Excise and Transport Department for their performance of Revenue collection. He has also appealed all HoDs to allow only double vaccinated public at their office premises and also display public awareness play card in this regard.
- 14. The Chairperson also directed the DO, Soil Conservation and DFDO, Jorhat to make a joint field visit at Misamari and Kapiapani Vety. Farm and report compliance.
- 15. The Chairperson appealed all the Heads of the Development Department to a submit Brief write up related to their on-going / upcoming works along with a detail progress report within the first week of every month henceforth (both Hard & Soft Copy). The Chairperson said that all Heads of Department may also submit the same to the mail id depjorhat@gmail.com.
