

MINUTES OF DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING OF JORHAT DISTRICT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL '2022 HELD ON 30/04/2022, IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, JORHAT

The members present are at Annexure I.

The meeting was presided over by Sri Ashok Kr. Barman, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat. The Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat welcomed all the members present and initiated the discussion.

The progress of works of various development departments were elaborately discussed in the meeting and decisions were arrived as follows:

1. PHE

The Executive Engineer PHE, Jorhat informed that the re-retrofitting works of Bonai Pathalial embankment PWSS has been kept pending due to the objection raised by Water Resources Deptt. After detail discussion it was decided to lay pipe line along the toe line of the embankment strictly maintaining 3 mtr. depth of the pipeline and accordingly Water Resources Department agreed and allowed to start the works. The Chairperson instructed the PHED & APDCL to conduct a joint survey for installation of dedicated power line of Greater Jorhat PWSS and APDCL will submit revised estimates before 5th May'22. The EE PHED also informed that 25 distribution zones out of 42 zone of Greater Jorhat PWSS will commissioned by 30th June 2022. EE also informed GDCL will complete 3 out of 4 Railway Crossing point under Greater Jorhat PWSS by 15th May'22. In this connection the Chairperson instructed the EE to monitor the works regularly and report. It was decided in the meeting, PWD will do the utility shifting (water pipe line) works simultaneously during construction of drains at KB Road,

The EE PHED intimated that smooth functioning of Greater Charigaon WSS is hampered due to shortage of pump operator and EE PHED requested to release Sri Mridul Borah Khalashi (plumber of PHED) who is presently attached at DC's Office, and in his place Sri Dilip Borah Gd.-IV , PHED , Jorhat may be attached. The Chairperson assured to release the said person.

The EE PHED also instructed for arrangement of Filtration Units to the Tea Garden Model School, communicating with PWD (B &NH), Jorhat and submit proposals to Govt. for obtaining necessary approval.

Irrigation

The EE Irrigation Jorhat, informed that 15 pin points has been selected at Ajarguri & Bolama area for installation of Solar operated pump in due consultation with Agriculture Department , but work yet to start due to bad weather, He also intimated that site selection is also going on for multiple cropping.

Discussion on Mudra Loan

The Chairman directed the LDM to convene a meeting on 4th May'22 at 3-00 PM , where Agriculture , Fishery , Veterinary Department will be present and also to invite all concerned Bank Branches to discuss all issues relating to Bank linkage programmes including Mudra Loans . LDM is also directed to prepare a up to date status /report covering all such Banks status.

Regarding PM Kissan Programme , the Chairperson suggested to include beneficiaries from all allied sectors .

Discussion on Amrit Sarovar

It was informed in the meeting that 75 Ponds will be built in Jorhat district in both Govt. / Community land under Amrit Sarovar programme for preservation of rain water and wet land development. The Chairperson appealed all to build/ create at least 100 water bodies though the district target is 75. The Agriculture / Vety. / Sericulture etc were instructed to provide un-used land status under their control immediately for development of water bodies, where Fishery Deptt would develop ponds and plantation will be done by P&RD. In this connection the DFDO, Jorhat will keep close coordination with all concerned departments. The DFDO also to submit a compile report on vacant land at the earliest.

Water Resources

During the discussion on vulnerable points of various embankment in the district, EE Water Resources informed that water of river Brahmaputra make a turn about 700 mtr in Upor Deori area and department planning to protect the area through bamboo fence. The Deptt also submitted P&E to the Govt. regarding protection of Upor Deori. The Chairperson strictly directed the EE concern to complete/ restoration of entire works immediately without further delay. The Chairperson instructed the EE to repair the embankment and make it motorable near Potia Fokola , before Ministers visit on 15th May'22.

Fishery

The DFDO informed that the building constructed for wholesale fish market in front of DFDO office remain unused since years. He also informed that the Building was handed over to JMB after completion. The Chairperson strictly directed to all concerned not to waste such Govt. properties set up for specific purpose and suggested the DFDO to use the building for vegetable market of local farmers and discussed the matter with JMB authority accordingly.

Education (IS / DEEO)

The Chairperson instructed the IS & EE, PWD (B &NH), Jorhat to resolve all issues relating to newly constructed 7 (seven) Model Schools in Tea Garden areas of the district before opening of Schools. Participating the discussion the representative of PWD (B) Jorhat informed that the Govt. would provide additional amount of Rs.50.00 L for each Model School and Model estimate would also be prepared at Govt. level In this connection the Chairperson instructed the PWD (Bldg) to submit justification to the Govt. for inclusion of Filtration unit of drinking water in special context of Jorhat district in the Model Estimate. The Inspector of Schools was directed to write a letter to CEO, ZP, Jorhat for survey of Schools in Jhanjimukh area.

Health

The Jt. Director, Health, Services, Jorhat intimated that Department has conducted 6 (Six) Health Camps during the month of March'22. Vaccination programme is also going on in the district. The Chairperson directed the Jt. Dir, to cause an enquiry about the Hokka Bar presently running at Jorhat and take steps for closing such Bars. The Jt. Director Health was directed to submit the Block wise list of Tea Garden Pregnant Women to LDM for registration under Tea Garden Pregnant Women schemes.

Social Welfare

During discussion on electrification of AWC, the DGM, APDCL informed that out of 2192 Schools/ AWC, electrification has been done in 1895. The Chairperson requested the DGM to provide the list of Schools/ AWC to EE PHED ,where electrification has been done. The DSWO intimated that due to shortage of skilled manpower , uploading in UDID portal has been hampered a lot. The Chairperson suggested Jt. Dir, Health to place one skilled employee from

their establishment. The Chairperson also directed the DSWO, Jorhat to write a letter to the Principal, Jorhat Medical College for placement of one English language teacher for Deaf & Dumb Schools.

The Chairperson also requested all heads of department, to inspect nearby AWC during their official field visit and report accordingly.

It was decided to hold DLCC of Social Welfare department on 4th May'22.

Miscellaneous Discussion

1. Transport - The DTO was directed to make arrangement and to communicate with ALC, Jorhat for registration of 200 skilled Drivers under e-shrom identified from recently concluded training programme. The ALC, Jorhat also instructed to communicate with all works departments to cover 100% registration under E- Shrom.
2. It was decided to allow the local vendor/ farmers to sale locally produced vegetable at Agri. Market Complex near Rajmau Pukhuri , once in a week . The IS , Jorhat was also suggested to visit Normal School Complex and identify the location may be developed for local vegetable market and report accordingly. The DSO, Jorhat was also requested to provide rooms at Stadium Complex for Agriculture University for showcase their products and product procedure.
3. The ARCS, Jorhat was directed to submit a report on inactive coop societies in the district and departments initiative to revive them and suggested to organize employment generation promotion programme.
4. NABARD – The DDM , NABARD informed that only 171 beneficiaries belongs to AGVB have participated in Kissan Bhagidari Prathamikta Campaign programme , out of total 36,920 PM Kissan Beneficiary in the district. The other Banks are not participated till date. The DDM appealed the District Administration to take steps for involvement of all other concerned banks for participation in the programme. In this regard the Chairperson directed the LDM, Jorhat to communicate with all Bank concerned for active participation in the campaigning programme.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
